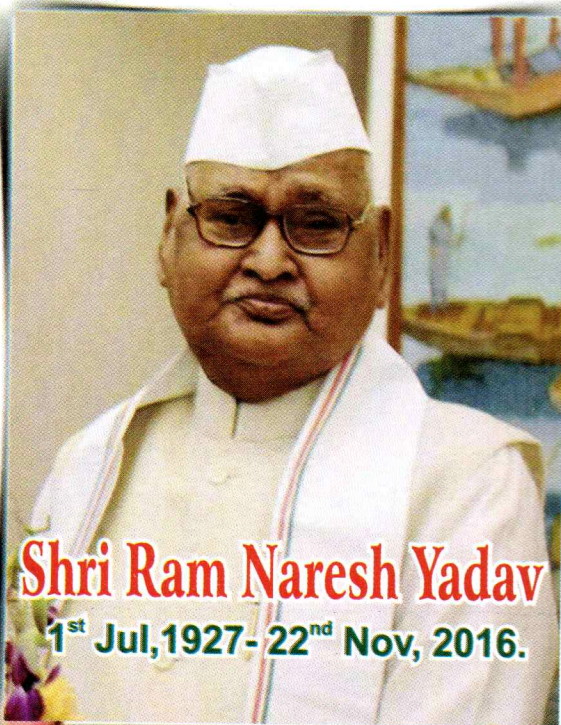

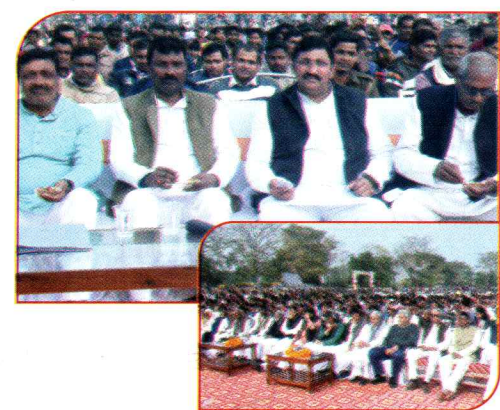

Admission Criteria :-

A. For the classes Ist to 11th students who have attended recognized English Medium School and are able to receive instructions in English at their level, are considered for admission. Admissions normally take place in March, on the basis of entrance tests and interviews. Applications for admission are entertained only for the classes in which vacancies are anticipated. Registrations can be closed at any time of the discretion of the Principal.

B. Transfer cases like new students coming into the city on transfer are considered for admission in the month of July, subject to the conditions mentioned above.

C. REGISTRATION does NOT guarantee Admission, which will be subject to suitability and availability of vacancies.

D. Admission to the school is subjected to the condition that consolidated fees for the year will have to be paid, if the student is withdrawn at any time later than the 30th of June.

E. A student will not be enrolled in any class until he/she produces a Transfer Certificate from the school last attended. The transfer certificate is needed to be countersigned by the District Inspector of School, if the candidate is from another State or Board.

Curriculum & Scheme of Study :-

The school is divided into Four Wings - Nursery-KG, Primary (1-V), Middle (VI-VIII), Secondary (IX & X). The School strictly follows the NCERT/CBSE Syllabus and prepare the students for All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) as per guidance of Examination Bye-Laws of C.B.S.E. N. Delhi

1. The subjects taught in Primary Wing (I-V) are: Moral Science, English, Hindi, Mathematics, EVS (I & II), PHE, Music, Art & Craft, Computer Science, Social Study (III to V), Science (III to V) & G.K, Computer Sc, & Moral values.
2. The subjects taught in Middle Wing (VI-VIII) are: English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Social Science, Science, PHE, Music, Art & Craft, & G.K.

IT Science, Social Science :-

3. The subjects taught in Secondary Wing (IX & X) are: English Literature (Course-A) Hindi (Course A), Mathematics,

House System :-

The whole school vertically divided into four Houses, named Sapphire (Blue), Topaz (Yellow), Ruby (Red) and Emerald (Green). This division provides opportunities for healthy competition in sports, games and other activities among the houses. Each house headed by House Masters who are responsible for grooming the students with the help of other house teachers in charges and house captains.



1. The school Academic Session extends from April to March. The course of studies is based on the syllabus prescribed by Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school curriculum is not only stimulating but also extremely precise in its approach.
2. The medium of instruction is English, the international language of today. Hindi however, has a vital role in the curriculum and is taught daily in all standards.
3. VMY International School is liberal and universal but at the same time it is Indian and firmly rooted in Indian History and Tradition.
4. The curriculum there for embraces English (literature & composition), Hindi (literature & composition), Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, Accountancy Economics, Business Studies & Commerce. Art & Craft, Games, Music, Tae-k-wondo & Physical Education along with vocational courses like Fashion Designing in also included in the curriculum.

An additional subject of prime importance environmental Education (EVS) and Moral science is also included in the curriculum.

Counseling and personality Development :-

Apart from classroom learning, workshops, outings, guest lectures, enter house and inter-school competitions & celebrations of festivals are arranged so that studies are exposed to varied and stimulating experience for their overall personality growth. THE SCHOOL PROVIDES P.D. CLASSES FROM CLASSES 6 & ABOVE MONTHLY ONCE AND CARRIER CLASSES FOR CLASSES 10+2.

Counseling Session :-

A healthy, well adjusted, happy mind function better than one which is full of worries and anxieties. The counseling sessions that the school has started aim at helping children with behavioral and emotional problems. Those with difficulties in learning, like dyslexic children and those with attention deficit disorders are also helped.



The School Infrastructure has been designed so as to incorporate all the facilities necessary for imparting holistic education.

Library Cum A/V Room :-

The Library has rich collection of Books on Various subjects. It includes Fables, Short Stories, Novels, Mythology, Encyclopedias, Dictionary, Maps & Charts, Reference Books, Magazines and News Papers etc. It also has provision for Audio-Visual with rich collections of CD's /DVD's. In the series of our effort to provide world class education we have smart classes in our school.

HCL Digi School :-

All Classrooms are equipped with Interactive Digital Boards, Audio System with Digital Contents and Knowledge repository developed by HCL Digi School. It's a new age technology movement that is fast becoming an imperative for audio visual searching.

Art & Craft, Other Activities :-

The School has facility to train students in various creative activities such as Art & Craft, Dance, Drama, Debate, Quiz, Music etc. It also provides necessary training for students interested in Martial Arts, Yoga & Physical Training etc.



Sports Arena :-

The School has facility to train students both in indoor and outdoor games such as Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Cricket, Table Tennis, Chess, Kabadi, Kho-Kho, Athletics etc.

Science Lab :-

The Composite Science Laboratory is fully equipped to fulfill the requirement of observation, demonstration and experimentation in Physics, Chemistry, Social Science Biology and Maths Lab separately dedicated for each subject upto Senior Secondary School Level (10+2).

Computer Lab :-

Computer Lab The Computer Lab has latest computers together with Internet + Wi-Fi Connectivity.





Affiliation :-

The School is recognized as a Co- educational. Secondary (10th) English Medium School & affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi and the affiliation of the School will be upgraded to 10+2 Higher Secondary level.

Admission Test Process :-

Admission in class I: Simple written Test & Oral Test

For classes II To V (Written Test) :-

English (M.M. 40), EVS (M. M. 30) Hrs. and Maths (M. M. 30)

Time duration for test will be 2-3 hrs for Combined question paper.

Model Question Papers are also provided at the time of registration

Required Documents for Admission :-

For Classes Nursery To UKG: Original date of Birth Certificate issued From Municipal Corporation or Gram Panchayat.

For Classes II To IX:

1. Original Transfer Certificate duly counter signed by competent authority.
2. Original Marks/Grade Card issued by previous school (for classes II to IX) and photo copy of Marks-Sheet.
3. Three passport size latest coloured photos.

The principal reserves the right to refuse admission without assigning any reason.

Fee :-

1. Fees is to be cleared before 15th of every month failing which, late fine shall be charged along with the fee after that date, which has to be submitted in the bank.
 2. School tuition fees are to be borne by the guardians for one full session (12 months).
 3. No exemption/deduction in fee will be made on account of broken period/holidays or absence from class.
 4. Prior to summer & winter vacations, if fees is not paid before the last working date, as per notice, the name of the student will not be included in the attendance register on the commencement of school.
 5. No student will be allowed to appear for examination unless all dues have been cleared.
 6. Non payment of fee for 2 consecutive months will lead to automatic removal and cancellation of admission from the school and in this case a child has to seek fresh admission after paying the full admission fee.
 7. Prior to the new academic session, the tuition fee for current month has to be paid by the guardian before the date intimated earlier failing which their wards will not be enrolled in new classes.
 8. The school fees cover twelve calendar months and may be paid in monthly installments or in advance. Pupils are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls.
 9. THIS SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INCREASE THE FEES AT ANY TIME OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, IF ANY INCREMENT IS DEEMED NECESSARY.
- IMPORTANT NOTES TO GUARDIANS WILL BE CONVEYED.



Transfer/Withdrawal Rules :-

1. Notice of withdrawal of pupil must be given in writing. One month's fee has to be paid in advance in lieu of the notice.
2. No leaving certificate (T.C.) will be issued until all dues to the school have been paid full with a receipt of a written application from the parent or guardian.
3. Transfer certificate will be issued only if the school office is informed one month before with the payment of Rs. 100/-; otherwise Rs. 500/- will be charged in lieu of the notice.
4. If the pupil needs counter signature on T.C., Rs. 500/- should be paid in advance with a written application

Parents are requested to collect progress reports of their wards regularly on the date announced by the school after every examination. The report cards must be returned to the school within three days of their receipt, failing which it will be considered lost and a duplicate card will be issued against payment of Rs. 100/-

Dismissal :-

A child may be expelled from the School on the following grounds:

1. Misbehavior with Principal, Vice-Principal or any Teaching Staff of the school.
2. Absence from the class for more than prescribed days.
3. Against proven in-disciplinary actions in the school premises or with the school students.
4. Non-payment of School-Fee For 3 consecutive months.





General Instructions



PARENT MEETING



Parents Teachers Meet are conducted for the overall development of the student and to check truancy. Meetings are conducted on predetermined dates for maximum response.

Parental Co-Operation :-

1. Parent are required to look into their child's school diary every day and see that the lessons and the homework assigned for the next day are done regularly and everyday. It should be countersigned by the parents.
2. If you feel that your child is not making the desired progress, please make it a point to discuss it with the Principal and class- teacher inside the school office only.
3. Criticism of a student's teacher & school in the presence of the child should be avoided because it may cause the student to lose respect for his her teacher as well as for the school.
4. Parents are not allowed to meet their children or the teacher during school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
5. Parents are requested to inform the school of any change of address and phone number.
6. (a) Parents are required to send their children to school in time.
(b) Presence of every child in the assembly is compulsory.
(c) The child who fails to reach the school in time & does not attend the assembly may be sent back home.
(d) Parents should not take the child out without prior permission of the Principal during school days.
(e) Children not feeling well may be sent to school with medicines during the school hours.
(f) Children will not be allowed to go home from school in between the school hours.
7. Please ensure that your ward takes part in all the activities of the school.

1. A minimum of 75% attendance is required to be eligible for promotion.
2. A pupil who fails and is not promoted to the next class may not be permitted to return to the school in the following year. Any child who fails TWICE in the same class will under no circumstances be permitted to return to the School.
3. The decision of the School Authorities regarding Promotion is final and will not be reconsidered, nor will there be any retest.
4. A fine of Rs. 50/- will be levied for the loss of a Report Card. Parents are to return the Report Card after signing. All test notebooks are sent home regularly and parents are required to sign every test as an indication that they are aware of their child's progress in the school.
5. Parents should check the School Diary daily for any Notice that are issued.
6. Daily homework and scheduled tests are also recorded in the school diary.
7. Parents/guardians or any other person is NOT allowed to meet their children or any staff member during school hours, without the previous sanction of the Principal, which must be obtained in writing. Parents of students of classes 1st to 10th can meet member of the staff on any working Saturday between 8.00 am and 10.00am.
8. Parents are expected to visit the School regularly for all functions and encourage their children to participate in all co-curricular activities which form an integral part of the school program.
9. Parents attendance is mandatory at "PTM".



Rules & Regulations



1. No child can be absent without a written application.
2. No leave or absence is granted except for serious reasons and no previous written application of parents/guardians. as a rule, not more than one day's leave of absence is granted to attend the wedding of a close family member. All applications for leave should be made BEFORE the leave is availed.
3. Trade arrivals after the vacations may have their names struck off the rolls.
4. Students affected by infections or those who have been exposed to such diseases in their homes must complete the required quarantine period before rejoining school. This should be indicated on the Medical Certificate.
5. School property wilfully damaged or destroyed will be required to be repaired. In addition a heavy fine may be imposed.
6. Every student should keep the school campus tidy, neat and clean. Bins are provided for any litter.
7. No books, newspaper/periodicals may be brought into the school premises without Principal's sanction.
8. The School is not responsible for any students loss of property. Students are responsible for looking after their books, personal items etc.
9. No jewellery is to be worn except a watch during examination and no make up of any kind is to be used. Nails are to be kept short.
10. Parents/Guardians are requested to notify the school, if any changes in address or telephone Numbers.
11. Every child is to attend assembly. The hours of class attendance are as notified in the school diary from time to time.
12. No student is permitted to leave the school during class hours for any reason.
13. Servants should be on time to take the children home. The school is not responsible for any children after working hours. Those students who have to wait for elder sisters will remain with the resident scholars in the classroom.
14. The use of unfair means in an examination test will entail the annulment of the entire result. If it occurs during the final examination, promotion may be denied. If the offence is repeated parent / guardians will be requested to withdraw the student concerned.
15. Students should address their teachers and all the members of the staff with due respect and politeness. They are expected to behave in a gentle manner. They should show respect and politeness to their companions too.
16. Students who have been absent from class must have the reason for their absence noted in their "Regularity Record". No leave of absence is granted without a previous application in writing from the guardian. Grant of leave is entirely upto the Principal.
17. There is no provision for "Reassessment or Promotion on Trial"



Enrollment in VMY International School, implies on the part of both pupils and parents a willingness to comply with all the requirements and rules of the School. The Principal has the right to suspend the attendance or require the withdrawal of any pupil without having to assign any reason, provided that he is satisfied that such a step is necessary in the interest of the school.

The Principal reserves the right to waive any of the rules contained herein without assigning any reason for his action.

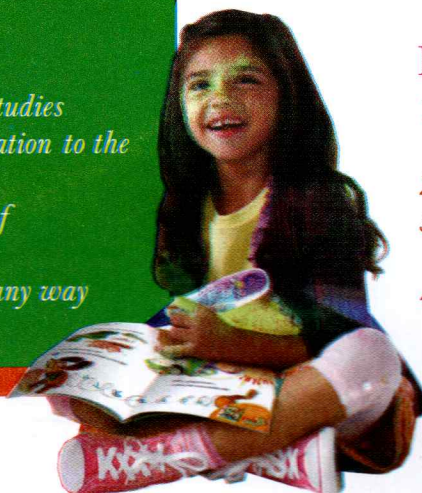

A student found guilty of gross misconduct may be asked to the withdrawn immediately from the school.

The following may be interpreted as constituting gross misconduct:

- a) Truancy from either Assembly or class.
- b) Habitual Late coming
- c) Shortage of Attendance
- d) Indifference towards studies
- e) Rudeness or Insubordination to the School Authorities.
- f). Cheating during a test of Examination.
- g). Any other act that in any way harms the school



Teachers / Faculty

School Library Rules :-

There is a well stocked fiction and reference Books and the school subscribes to a variety of magazines and newspapers. Children are encouraged to use the Library regularly especially to prepare for the projects and other work. A computer in the library gives students access to the internet for reference work.

1. Only one book will be issued at a time.
2. Book can be returned on the respective class days.
3. A pupil can issue a book for a week only.
After his due date Rs. 2/- per day fine will be imposed.
4. If the books lost, the borrower must replace it or pay the actual price in lieu of replacement.
5. No fine will be charged for books overdue if a letter produced is showing that the borrower was absent for valid reason.

Laboratory Rules :-

1. Enter the laboratory with prior permission of the Teacher or Lab Assistant.
2. Maintain silence in the laboratory.
3. Do not touch any equipment or chemical without teacher's permission.
4. Any damage caused to the equipments/instruments intensely will be charged an amount equal to the cost equipments/instruments damaged.

Discipline :-

Every student is urged to contribute to the high tone of the School by his manners and deportment. Parents/Guardians are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularly of attendance and discipline and taking an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school.





School Uniform :-

The school uniform should be worn daily, Every child is expected to bathe daily and wear fresh clothes every morning. Children with dirty cloths, shoes, heads etc. will not be allowed to attend class.

Physical Training Uniform :-

Boys : House T. Shirt & White Pants. White Canvas Shoes & Socks, Prescribed Belt and Tie.

Girls: House T. Shirt divided, White Skirt, White Canvas Shoes & Socks, Prescribed Belt and Tie

Class- Work & Home-Work :-

1. Class work, which includes oral and written work, class - tests are taken into consideration for promotion.
2. At primary level and Junior High School level, homework in English, Maths, Science and other optional Subjects is given regularly as per the schedule. Guardians are requested to see that their children complete their homework every day.

Educational Tours :-

Educational tours, to the destinations of historical, cultural and industrial importance, are organized during the break. This is in addition to the outings or excursions.



School Transport

1. the School provides facilities of transport by bus and van although it involves great expenditure, the whole idea is to educate younger generation especially for those students who stay far from the main town.
2. Withdrawal from conveyance facility must be preceded by a month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
3. Conveyance Charges for Vacations will also have to be deposited.
4. The school has a fleet of buses for students and staff which covers various routes in the city and other places and this facility is available to each part of the city.

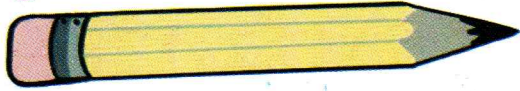

We have high expectations of students and encourage self-discipline

All students are expected to behave in a responsible manner and show consideration, courtesy and respect for other people, property and their surroundings. The School's Code of Conduct and Behavior for learning policy is clearly spelt out to students and there are well defined courses of action which may be taken if students misbehave. When problems occur, parents are kept closely informed and if necessary, are invited into the school to discuss the situation. A five tier system of consequences does operate for those students whose activities challenge the Code of Conduct. Detention, target setting reports and in very serious cases exclusion are sanctioned employed to support our Behavior for learning Policy. 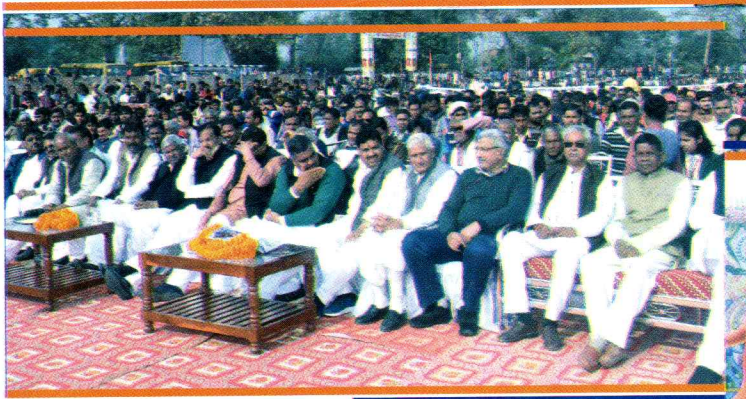


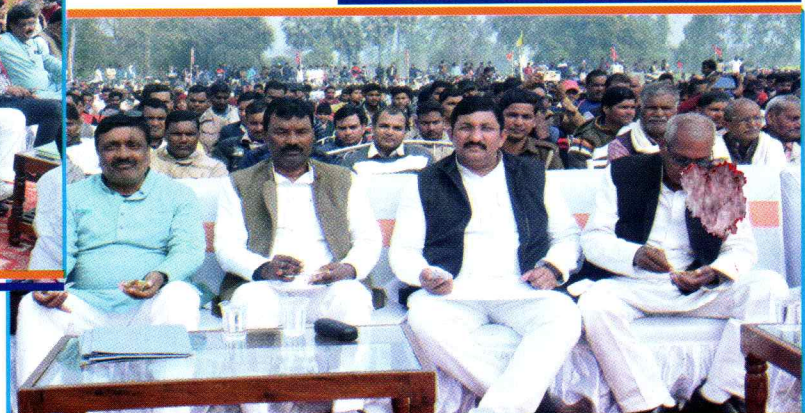

If the student has previously attended a school, we require copies of his/her most recent school reports and Transfer Certificate alongwith a statement from the school regarding his/her character and dialy Complete Forms may be submitted to the school office

The principal has the right to suspend the attendance or require the withdrawal of any pupil without having to assign any reason. provided that she is satisfied that such a step is necessary in the interest of the school. The Principal reserves he right to waive any of the rules contrained herein without assigning any reason for his action. Reports based on the continuous assessment of a student's work will be distributed four times in each academic year for classes 1 to 10. The first and third reports are assessments of the students' progress as evidence in the class tests which are held between March and May, July and December respectively. The second and fourth reports are of the marks obtained in the Half Yearly and Final Examinations, respectively.

In the case of classes 1 to 10, reports are based on the continuous assessment of a student's work which are distributed four times in each academic year.

If for any reason the report is not received, parents /guardians are requested to contact the school office immediately.

A child who is absent for any paper or test, forfeits the marks completely. The decision of the school authorities is final and binding.

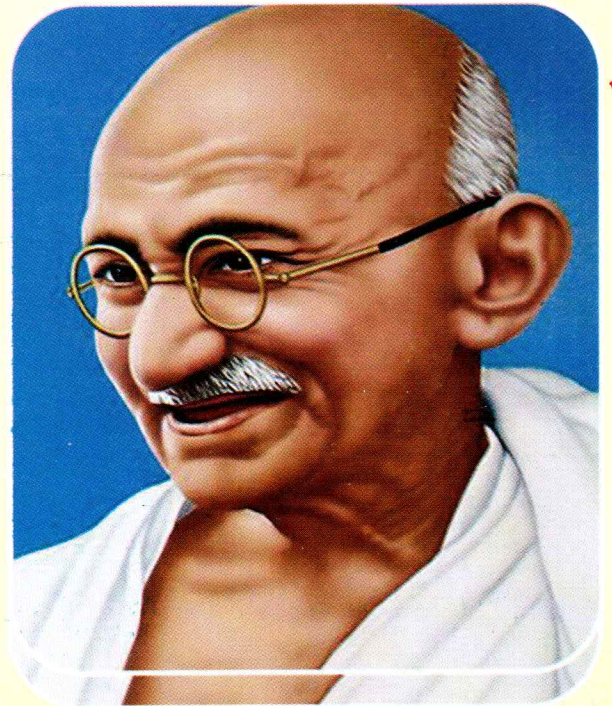

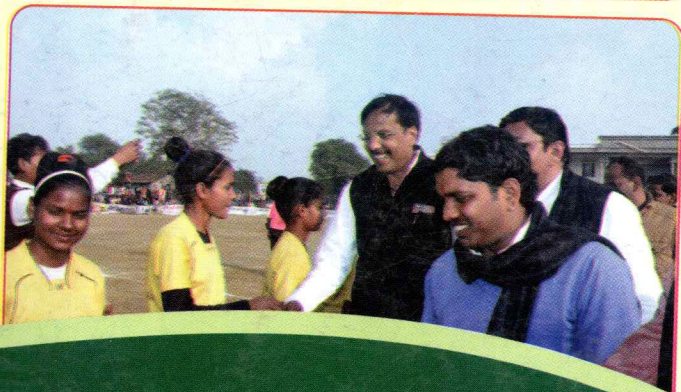
